You need to know that the Census is:

MPORTANT

- > Look for Census forms in the mail in mid-March
- > Census data is used to distribute more than \$675 billion in federal funds to support states, counties & communities for schools, healthcare, roads & other vital programs
- > The Census determines the number of seats in the U.S. House of Representatives each state will have and is used to draw congressional and state legislative districts.
- > All people living in your home must be counted
- > If you have more than one address, use the one where you live most of the time
- > If you have any census issue, go to www.2020census.gov or call 800-923-8282

EASY

- > Less than 10 questions per person
- > 4 ways to respond: online, telephone, mail, or census taker

SAFE

- > Federal law prohibits the Census Bureau and its employees from releasing any information about an individual under penalty of imprisonment or fine or both
- > No citizenship question. No documentation question
- > No one can share your personal information with any government entity, including ICE, the FBI or the police
